- 2. What are some of the different characteristics of the moku on Hawai'i Island? What does it mean when 'Anakala Keoni says the island is growing and expanding?
- 3. What are some of the unique characteristics of the district where you live? How can you get to know what is kaulana, or famous, on the island where you live?
- 4. What is the difference between the terms, "Hawai'i Island," "Big Island," and "Moku o Keawe"? How are these terms used in normal speech?
- 5. If you could visit any of the moku on Hawai'i Island, which would it be? Why?
- 6. The characteristics described by 'Anakala Keoni are all part of the island's natural landscape. Make a list or draw a picture of ten or more special things found in nature that are characteristic of where you live.
