- 3. If your mother was born in China and you were born in Hawai'i, do you both have the same nationality?
- 4. What is the difference between nationality and ethnicity?
- 5. The Lāhui Hawai'i includes everybody who was born in Hawai'i. The Lāhui 'Ōiwi includes only those with Native Hawaiian ethnicity. Is this distinction important? Why or why not?
- 6. Take a poll to find out how many nationalities you have in your classroom. Then take a poll to see how many ethnicities there are. Do you think the results would be similar at your cousin's school?
