- 4. In a loko i'a, what is the difference between pua, or fingerlings, and natural predators? Give examples.
- 5. Some families and organizations in Hawai'i are restoring traditional loko i'a to be used as a food source. In what ways could these efforts help Hawai'i in the long term?
- 6. What would you need to be able to construct a loke i'a? How might you become involved in loke i'a restoration?
