## Specific questions

1. Who are the parents of Moloka'i? What are some things Moloka'i is famous for?
2. Why is it important to know about the resources and history of the island?
3. What does 'Anakala Walter mean when he says that Moloka'i is a "baby" that needs to be taken care of? How can you take care of the island or place where you live?
4. What is the difference between Lanikāula in eastern Moloka'i and Kaluako'i on the western side of the island?
5. Moloka'i is known for sharing its abundance with the rest of the islands. Where do we see evidence of this tradition? Is it still possible to live this way? Why or why not?
6. Fish are not as plentiful as they once were, because reefs along Moloka'i have been damaged by soil erosion and other runoff. If you were to make a poster about the importance of clean water and reefs, what kind of images would you include? What would you write on the poster?
